How to write a Short-Answer Response

The University of Wisconsin Teaching Academy calls short answer questions "constructed response", or "open-ended questions that require students to create an answer." The Center for Teaching Excellence at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign says that short answer questions allow students to present an original answer.

Tips for Teaching Constructed Response with the RACE Acronym. 1.) Practice with short texts specifically to teach the RACE strategy FIRST. Introducing it in a nonthreatening way with short texts will allow the students to learn the process and importance before moving on to lengthy grade level texts.

Tips for Teaching RACE Constructed Response Strategy ...

Your answer should show the interviewer that you're excited about teaching in teaching in general, and that you'll connect with this job in particular. To demonstrate the latter, come prepared with an answer that reflects your teaching philosophy and career path, as well as your skills and qualifications.

How to Answer "Why Did You Decide to Become a Teacher?"

Avoids pronouns. (Defines all nouns in this short response to avoid confusion.) Writes a complete, coherent response. (The scorer only reads what is written-not the original question. The response must be complete, giving context.) Uses basic conventions (capitalization, spelling, grammar, etc.).

Constructed Responses Require Textual Evidence

To receive full credit for responses, students must fully answer the question using their own words. For the above prompt, many students parroted the prompts or excessively quoted them for Part A rather than describing the differences in their own words.

Short Answer. Short answer questions usually ask students to list, name, define, or identify. Therefore, review your notes and try to anticipate what information falls under those categories. For instance, if you're studying World War II, try identifying the causes of the War, defining each country's stance, and listing the repercussions.
